Nicholas Warren qualified as a solicitor in 1973. He worked for the Child Poverty Action Group and the Family Rights Group before running a community advice centre from his home until 1992.

He was appointed in 1992 to be a Full Time Chairman of the Independent Tribunal Service to chair Social Security Appeal Tribunals, and in 1998 as the Regional Chairman of the North West Region. He has national responsibility for Tribunal procedure and has lately taken on national responsibility for training SSCS Tribunal Judges and Panel Members.

He was a member of the Lord Chancellor's Advisory Committee on legal aid from 1992 to 1995. He has been a Recorder since 1992 and was appointed President of the Gambling Appeals Tribunal in 2007. He was a Deputy Social Security Commissioner 1997 to 2004. For many years a CAFOD board member, he became a Trustee in 2000.
